## Mushroom vendor stabbed during robbery

condition after he was repeatedly stabbed and assaulted during a robbery on Eastury Drive in Phoenix on Tuesday.

The victim was a resident of Choppers Town in Mt Moreland and was selling mushrooms in Phoenix when he decided to visit his mother who lives in the area. Shortly after leaving her residence, he was accosted by six men while walking on the Phoenix Highway. Without warning, a suspect drew a knife and started stabbing him while the remaining men began assaulting him. During the attack, the victim was robbed of R2,000 in cash and his Samsung cellphone. The suspects then fled the scene on foot. The victim sought assistance from employees of a panel beating business that is being run from a home on Eastbury Drive.

A 24-year-old man is in a serious but stable The man was bleeding extensively from wounds to his face, back and chest. He was treated on scene by medics from a local security company who were called to the scene by an employee of the panel beating business, chest and back. Metro police on scene and security forces conducted an extensive search of the area, however, no arrests have been made. The suspects still remain at large.

## **Disgruntled husband** assaulted by civilians

A 29-year-old man was allegedly severely assaulted after two men who witnessed him attempting to grab the handbag of a woman on Todd Street in Verulam on Saturday. Members of a local security company arrived on scene following the public reporting an assault in progress. Upon arrival, a man was found bleeding excessively from an open wound to his head.

The woman explained that the injured man was her husband of nine years and since their separation this year, he began harassing her. She was in possession of a protection order. When he saw her on Todd Street, approached her. An argument broke out

During the argument, he grabbed her handbag and attempted to flee when two occupants of a VW Polo stopped to assist the

Medics treated the man on scene for his injury, however, he declined further medical attention. Both parties proceeded to the Verulam SAPS to register criminal cases against one another.

## Man fatally electrocuted

An unidentified man was killed after he was electrocuted by an illegal electricity connection at an informal settlement in Canelands, Verulam, on Saturday morning.

The Verulam Operations Centre of a security company received a call from a resident in the area requesting assistance for an individual who was suspected of being elec-

trocuted. Upon arrival, paramedics from the Provincial Ambulance Service were on scene and had declared him dead on scene.

He suspected of being electrocuted by an illegal connection. The deceased's identity has not been established at this s t a g e . Communications officer of Verulam SAPS, Cpt Henry Kisten, said, "A case has been opened at Verulam SAPS. Police are investigating further."

## DLC slams the municipality for incorrect meter readings

Democratic Liberal Congress (DLC) leader Patrick Pillay denounced the unfair treatment of ratepayers when charges in their utility bills are incorrect and is not a true reflection of their water and electricity consumption costs. After two years of the implementation of the Revenue Management Systems, ratepayers and pensioners are still faced with the challenges of incorrect billing, more especially in the incorrect electricity and water meter readings.

When 74-year-old pensioner Ramkissoon Singh and his 69-year-old pensioner wife received their electricity account last month, they were left shocked at the huge bill.

Singh said that he and his wife were traumatised and had no idea on how to deal with the issue. "When we went to the Municipal offices in Phoenix, we were told that we must pay our account," he said.

"Failing to get any positive responses from the Municipal offices, we approached the always helpful and considerate DLC offices for assistance. We are really grateful for the DLC's intervention and are pleased that something will now be done about our huge account," said Singh. DLC leader Patrick Pillay said that when the Singh's approached his office, they were really stressed and could not contain their emotions. "I was very worried about the state of their health and immediately my DLC activist and I attended to their emotional state of minds and calmed them down. Upon analysing the Singh's account, I picked up that there was an incorrect meter reading that was captured that resulted in their account escalating to over R200, 000. I made strong representations with Treasury to immediately investigate and make the necessary adjustments and reversals," said Pillay.

## Do not carry large sums of cash, warn police

As the festive season approaches, much emphasis is being placed on safety and vigilance. Following various incidents throughout the year, police are once again warning members of the public to not carry large sums of money during the holidays.

They urge residents to rather consider other options including carrying as little cash as possible and making use of cellphone banking and internet banking.

Police spokesman, Col Thulani Zwane, said, "We are concerned after recent incidents where people are robbed of their cash or even injured in the process. This guidance has been issued to prevent such incidents in future." He provided the following tips that will help

- minimise the chances of becoming a victim of robberies:

  · Alternate the days and times on which you deposit cash
- · Refrain from making cash deposits
- · Never make your bank visits public, even to people close to you
- · Do not openly display the money you are

depositing while you are standing in the bank queue Avoid carrying money bags, briefcases or openly displaying your deposit receipt book

- · It's advisable to identify another branch nearby that you can visit to ensure that your banking pattern is not easily recognisable or detected
- · If the amount of cash you are regularly depositing is increasing as your business grows, consider using the services of a cash management company
- · Refrain from giving wages to your contract or casual labourers in full view of the public rather make use of wage accounts that can be provided by your bank
- Refrain from driving to the bank in your company branded vehicle on a typical 'pay day'
- · Consider arranging for electronic transfers of wages to your contract or casual labourers' personal bank accounts

Police are also warning all stokvel members to take extra precautions when dealing with large amounts of cash as these types of cases are very prevalent during the festive season when members are sharing money.

"Stokvels are advised to arrange with their banks to deposit cash into their accounts. Citizens are cautioned not to withdraw large amounts of cash or transport large sums for deposits as often criminals have been tipped off and follow people to and from banks with them intention to rob them," he added.





## Mazda Design boss says new BT-50 will be 'tougher'

he Design Head of Mazda has announced that the next generation BT-50 will have a tougher appearance than the current model, but acknowledged that it will be a challenge keeping it in-line with the brand's current styling direction.

Reiterating comments made at the Tokyo Motor Show last year, Ikuo Maeda told Australia's drive.com.au at the Los Angeles Auto Show that the automaker had "learnt a lesson" from trying to apply its previous styling language to the BT-50, saying that the next generation, which will swap the current Ford Ranger T6 platform for that of the next Isuzu D-Max, will be more "butch" in spite of the inherent difficulty it once again faces looks-wise.

"I think our image is that we should be able to cover [this new Kodo design language] from SUV to passenger cars, but [with the] pick-up truck the rear tray has to be very flat so trying to deploy this [in the same way] is going to be very, very difficult. It is also going to be very difficult to showcase this light texture because of the sheer size of the vehicle. And also with a pick-up truck you want to have an appearance that has more strength, is butch and masculine. That's what I hope [for]," Maeda said.

While expressing confidence that the Kodo design language could possibly add more masculinity to the BT-50 if applied correctly, Maeda however said that the biggest concern is whether the interior fit-and-finish will match that of other models, such as the new 3, in keeping with the brand's premium push.

"Design quality we will take care of, but fit and finish I am not quite sure. The commercial vehicle has a significant importance within our lineup, so we will definitely be looking to improve that. I presume interior will be pretty difficult as the cost does not allow us to do anything... probably," he said.

Along with its new platform, the BT-50 will also drop the Ranger's current assortment of engines for Isuzu sourced units when it reportedly debuts in 2020, a year after the all-new D-Max.

## BMW boss defends AWD, turbo M-cars as more M3 details emerge

MW's Head of Development has continued lashing out at criticism over the use of turbocharging and all-wheel drive in its M models, describing the remarks as "not appreciated".

In a follow-up interview with US publication Road and Track, Klaus Fröhlich said the use of normally aspirated motors in previous M3 models impacted on the steering due to the extra weight over the front axle, making them

"People told me M cars can't be turbo. They have always been high-revving naturally-aspirated engines. Honestly, this high-revving engine was a V10, or a V8 in the 3-series, and it was so many pounds on the front axle, the steering was awful. It's not the boring turbocharged engine, it's revving, revving, revving" Fröhlich

Taking a swipe at disapproval after the introduc-



tion of the all-wheel drive M5, Fröhlich, who two months said he did "not want to hear sh\*t anymore" after negative media reports following the unveiling of the new G20 3-series, said the addition of all-wheel drive has in effect curbed understeer and contributed to making the amount of power available more useable.

"I hate understeering all-wheel drive cars. Most cars, if you push them hard, or if you're not such an experienced driver and you tear at the steering wheel, you get understeer. The fun is gone. So I told [former M boss] Frank Van Meel, whenever I drive the car, it should never, never understeer," he said.

"If you have more than 600 horsepower, a rearwheel drive car loses nearly one second in 0-60mph (96km/h). And by the way, the new M5 with all-wheel drive weighs less than the predecessor without it".

Asked about the next generation M3 and M4, Fröhlich, who previously confirmed that the latter would be the last to offer a manual gearbox, said both will become available with all-wheel drive at some stage, but added that the rearwheel drive layout will indeed be kept.

"I think there is still a big market for pure rear-

wheel drive. I always really appreciated what Porsche did on the 911. They have whatever new derivative every month. I think we missed some opportunity not doing the same on M4. So I'm interested that, on M3, M4, we do more. This car will be rear-wheel drive, but we will have an allwheel drive derivative too".

In a subsequent related report, Britain's Autocar, citing alleged BMW officials including CEO

Harald Krüger at the recent Paris Motor Show, confirmed that the next M3 will indeed not be rear-wheel driven, but have the option of a sixspeed manual gearbox.

According to the publication, the decision not to include all-wheel drive or electrification like Mercedes-AMG's 53-line of models, came as a result of weight with the end goal of making the newcomer lighter than the now discontinued M3 CS that tipped the scales at 1 586kg.

The article also alleges that the G20 M3 will continue with the current 3.0-litre turbocharged straight-six engine, but with heavy revisions and indeed water-injection to lift power from 317kW to 347kW, 15kW more than the F80 M3 Competition Package (CP). Gone however is the seven-speed M DCT 'box in favour of an eight-speed Steptronic, while the CP will likely use the new S58 motor from the forthcoming X3 and X4 M that will generate a reported

With speculation building that the M3 could possibility make its world debut in Geneva next year, the M4 is only slated to arrive in 2020, a year after the standard 4-series make its alleged

## Volkswagen Amarok's Dark side exposed

Iready available in Australia and United Kingdom, Volkswagen South Africa has now officially confirmed local pricing and spec details for the special edition Amarok Dark Label.

First shown at the Frankfurt Motor Show last year, the Dark Label differentiates itself from lesser models by being finished in a model specific Indium Grey matte paint with grey Dark Label stripes, along with matte black door handles, mirrors, a locally sourced Maxe sports bar and door sills, tinted rear windows, matte black grille, smoked taillight clusters and bespoke 18-inch Rawson alloy wheels.

Inside, the changes are less dramatic and include a black head-liner, Vienna leather seats, chrome air vents and Dark Label embroidered floor mats. Standard equipment remains intact too, consisting of the Composition Media infotainment system, bixenon headlights with daytime running LEDs, a multi-function steering wheel, tyre

pressure monitor, front and rear parking sensors and Automatic Post-Collision Braking. Optionally, the Dark Label can be outfitted with the Discover Media infotainment system that adds satellite navigation, climatic air-conditioning, heated front seats and a reverse camera.

Unlike its Down Under and UK siblings though, South African-spec Dark Labels will eschew the 3.0 TDI V6 engine for the 2.0 BiTDI motor that produces 132kW/420Nm, mated to the eight-speed Tiptronic gearbox and permanent 4Motion all-wheel drive. As with the standard 132kW Amarok, the Dark Label's performance figures are unchanged with a top speed of 179km/h and 0-100km/h in 11.3 seconds. Combined fuel consumption is a claimed 8.5-litres/100km.

Slotting-in between Highline and Highline Plus variants, the Dark Label carries a sticker price of R674 600 which includes a three year/100 000km warranty and a five year/90 000km service plan.


